## REVISED MINIMUM SAFE MANNING SCALE

As part of our quality measures in improving the Tuvalu Ship Registry, with effect from 15 September 2007, the minimum safe manning scale has been revised as follows –

**Note:**

Please refer to Marine Circular Ref. 20/2007 dated 30<sup>th</sup> August 2007 on the definition of "Near Coastal Voyages".

Dates of compliance for the revised minimum safe manning scale are as follows:

- i) Vessel registered after 15 September 2007 has to comply with the revised minimum safe manning scale upon registration.
- ii) Vessel that is registered provisionally before 15 September 2007 will have to comply with the revised manning scale when it is transferred to permanent registry.
- iii) Vessel that is registered permanently before 15 September 2007 will have to comply with the revised manning scale when the registry of the vessel is due for annual renewal.

The Tuvalu Ship Registry reserves the right to either bring forward or extend the date of compliance of the revised minimum safe manning scale for each vessel on a case-to-case basis.

We believe that responsible ship owners and managers will appreciate the above measure, as this will also help to ensure that there is proper watch-keeping for their vessels at all times and adequate rest for their crew.
